






Tarantulas spiders dig deep underground soil to make burrows using their silk webbing. Some tarantula spiders live on the ground under rocks, logs, and trees.

Tarantula spiders live around the world and can be found in North America and South America, Africa, Europe, and Asia.

Deserts, Rainforest, Forest, Jungles, and Grassland.

What do Tarantula Spiders Eat?

Tarantula spiders are carnivores, Which means they eat only insects and meat. Frogs, Toads, Mice, Birds, grasshoppers, and Lizards, Also Insects are their main diet.



Hibernation

Tarantula spiders do hibernate in the winter, They hide underneath tree bark, under a rock, or leaves to keep them warm.

Some Tarantula spiders will make a winter nest around themselves in underground burrows.





<u>Life Span</u>

Tarantula spiders can live up to 30 years.

Length and Weigh

Tarantula spiders can weigh up to I to 3 ounces. The Tarantula spiders length is 4 inches long. Tarantula Spiders' legs span length is II inches long.

<u>3 Fun Fact About Tarantula Spiders</u>

- Tarantula spiders can climb using retractable claws end of each leg.
- Tarantula spiders shed their external skeletons called molting.
- Tarantula spiders can produce silk, which they use to line their burrows.
